ANNOUNCER: The Government of the Netherlands and the UNDP continue with remediation of impound of Zinc and Lead Mine in Mojkovac aiming to enable further development and economic progress of the north of Montenegro. The Government of the Netherlands invested over 2mln USD in this project.

ANNOUNCER: The Government of the Netherlands supports this project in order to protect the environment which is a basic condition for better life of future generations.

H.E. Mr Ronald J. P. M. van Dartel, Ambassador of the Kingdom of the Netherlands: We want Tara to remain clean and to continue to attract tourists and, on the other hand, to develop ecological awareness and introduce new technologies.

ANNOUNCER: For these purposes, countries in the region have 15 millions USD in its disposal through financial assistance of the Government of the Netherlands. Regarding Montenegro, the accent is on Mojkovac and its economic development and removal of main barrier for foreign investments.

Mr. Alexander Avanesov, UNDP Resident Representative/UN Resident Coordinator: Role of the UNDP is to manage donation in order to attract investments and prepare the Municipality for application in the European funds. Since its closing, the Mine is a source of pollution and represents permanent ecological threat to the city and river Tara.

ANNOUNCER: Vice-President of the Government, Ms. Gordana Djurovic, stressed that till now 4mln euros were invested in the remediation of impound. Total project is worth 10mln euros and the works will be ended till 2010.
