REPRESENTATIVES OF THE GOVERNMENT OF THE KINGDOM OF THE NETHERLANDS AND UNDP SATISFIED WITH WORKS IN MOJKOVAC

Mojkovac- Deputy Prime Minister said at a yesterday's press conference held in Mojkovac that the Government is satisfied with recent works carried out on the impound and that about 2, 5 million of Euros from the budget of Montenegro for 2009 were planned for that project . Through this, as she said, the Government continues to finance that important plan in cooperation with UNDP and the Government of the Netherlands.

About 4 million of Euros were invested so far, whereas the whole project of remediation of a great ecological problem that was recognized in the regional project of UNDP is worth 10 million of Euros. Finishing of the works on the impound is expected to be done by 2010 and that will represent affirmation of a good cooperation of the state of Montenegro, a donor community and international organizations, such as UNDP and our important partners in the EU, the Government of the Netherlands and Czech, said Mrs. Djurovic.

H.E. Mr Ronald J. P. M. van Dartel, Ambassador of the Kingdom of the Netherlands stressed that the impound is part of the regional programme for environmental protection and that he is impressed with the results.

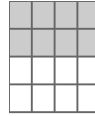
-Healthy and reliable policy of environmental protection enables economic progress of the state and creating of new work places in the future, said Mr. Dartel.

Mr. Alexander Avanesov, UNDP Resident Representative/UN Resident Coordinator stressed that a year passed since the project was started and that the results could be already seen.

-When we purify the impound terrain, we will have one much more beautiful space, and health of people will be protected. The space will be serving for recreation and joy and that is excellent solution for the regional and national problem. The river Tara is streaming near the impound and it belongs to the world's heritage, by cleaning the impound you will preserve the national and world's natural heritage. We have very good cooperation with Montenegrin Government that invests into development of the north, but personnel potential is still under lower level than in other parts of the country and we can expect further development and progress in that context, said Mr. Avanesov.

Director of Directorate of Public Works Zarko Zivkovic stressed that works on remediation of the impound are under the process for five years and that is about one of the most important projects. So far, fist phase has been completely realised and it cost about 3.870.000 Euros and 50 percent of the works have been completed.

President of the Municipality Miladin Mitrovic expressed gratitude in the name of the local authorities to the Government of Montenegro, which initiated the project of remediation of the impound, and to the Governments of the Netherlands and Czech, and international organisations of UNDP, which is monitoring the project and helps its realisation.

Za nastavak revitalizacije jalovišta Vlada će izdvojiti 2,5 miliona eura

Umjesto jalovišta tereni za rekreaciju

Mojkovac - Potpredsjednica Vlade **Gordana Đurović** na jučerašnjoj konferenciji za novinare u Mojkovcu, saopštila je da je Vlada zadovoljna dosadašnjim radovima na jalovištu i da u kapitalnom budžetu Crne Gore za 2009. godinu za taj projekat predviđeno oko 2,5 miliona eura. Time, kako je kazala Đurović, Vlada nastavlja da finansira taj bitan projekat u saradnji sa UNDP i Vladom Holandije.

- Do sada je uloženo oko 4 miliona eura, a cijeli projekat sanacije velikog ekološkog problema koji je prepoznat i u regionalnom projektu UNDP-a, je težak i preko 10 miliona eura. Završetak radova na jalovištu se očekuje u 2010. godini i to će biti afirmacija dobre saradnje države Crne Gore sa donatorskom zajednicom, sa međunarodnim organizacijama kao što je UNDP sa našim važnim partnerima u EU, Vladom Holandije i u prethodnoj fazi Vladom Češke - kazala je Đurović.

Ambasador Kraljevine Holandije **Ronald van Dartel** je istakao da je jalovište dio regionalnog programa za zaštitu životne sredine i da je impresioniran rezultatima.

- Zdrava i pouzdana politika zaštite životne sredine omogućava ekonomski napredak države i stvaranje novih radnih mjesta u budućnosti - kazao je Dartel.

Aleksandar Avanesov stalni predstavnik UNDP u Crnoj Gori je istakao da je protekla godina dana od početka projekta i već se vide rezultati.

- Kad se teren jalovišta raščisti imaćemo jedan mnogo ljepši prostor i zdravije ljudi biće zaštićeno. Prostor će poslužiti za rekreaciju i užitek, i to je sjajno rješenje regionalnog i nacionalnog ekološkog problema. Pored jalovišta protiče rijeka Tara, a ona spada u prirodno nasljeđe svijeta, pa time što ćete očistiti jalovište čuvate i nacionalno i

svjetsko prirodno nasljeđe. Imamo jako dobru saradnju sa Vladom Crne Gore, koja ulaže u razvoj sjevera, ali su kadrovski potencijali još na nižem nivou nego u drugim djelovima države, pa u tom kontekstu očekujemo budući napredak i razvoj - kazao je Avanesov.

Direktor Direkcije za javne radove **Zarko Živković** je naglasio da se posljednjih pet godina izvode radovi na jalovištu i da se radi o jednom od najznačajnijih projekata. Do sada je u potpunosti realizovana prva faza koja je koštala oko 3.870.000 eura i 50 odsto poslova je završeno.

Predsjednik Opštine **Miladin Mitrović** se u ime lokalne uprave zahvalio Vladi Crne Gore koja je započela projekat sanacije jalovišta, kao i vladama Češke i Holandije i međunarodnoj organizaciji UNDP koja prati projekat i pomaže njegovu realizaciju.
