The programme referred rafting on the river Tara and introducing of the kayaking on this river. Guests of the programme were Mr. Dejan Medojevic, Director of TO Mojkovac and Mr. Ranko Misnic, President of Tara rafting club. Among other things, Mr. Medojevic said that TO Mojkovac is one of the youngest local tourist organisations and that it has a main goal to valorise tourist potentials of the city of Mojkovac. He stated that TO Mojkovac particularly stresses part of the river Tara that pertains to Mojkovac, which so far, wasn't fully valorised, and it gave them idea to take advantage of that part of the Tara for kayaking. Mr. Medojevic said that TO Mojkovac has found UNDP as strategic partner in this project, i.e. projecting team of UNDP, Ms Milica Begovic and Mr. Borko Vulikic. He said that UNDP has hired Slovenian consultant Jernej Stritih, who has developed pilot project for kayaking on the Tara river and that after that TO Mojkovac, jointly with Austrian –Montenegrin partnership office and rafting club Tara entered the project of training young people for kayaking. "Therefore, we have hired Mr. Ales Fon over UNDP, and he came and stayed several days in Mojkovac, where he trained 15 young men from Tara rafting club. Our next goal is to mark there entering and exiting points on the Tara and we hope that we can start with kayaking this year". He said that they are working in partnership with Ministry of Tourism and UNDP on hiking and biking project. He has concluded that there is very good cooperation between TO Mojkovac and UNDP. He has stated the project under realization of Mojkovac Municipality and UNDP considering rehabilitation of tailings mine impound, as an example of such cooperation.
